## ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF VENDOR AGREEMENT

LLIWS requires a 30 day written cancellation on exhibitor space.

 Fees: We accept VISA, MasterCard, AMEX or cash. Checks on commercial or personal accounts WILL NOT be accepted. All fees are due NO LATER THAN JULY 1, 2019

- 2. Vendor Specifications and Requirements
  - Assignment & Location: Assignments and space location shall be at the sole discretion of ILLWS and is subject to change
  - Set-Up: Starting 8 am, Saturday, Ju.y 27, 2019. <u>Must be set-up by 1 hour prior to the first game of 9am.</u>
  - Move-Out: Must be moved out by Noon, August 5, 2019
  - Tournament Dates & Times: 9am to 9pm, July 28 to August 4, 2019.
- 3. Equipment & Personnel
  - Damages: Vendor shall not damage the park or facilities. Any such damage will be charged to exhibitor and may result in expulsion from the park and exclusion from future events
- 4. Infringements: CANNOT sell, display or giveaway any of the following: alcohol, merchandise containing name and/or logo of the event title, or the Little League World Series. All merchandise must be licensed. Products must be pleasing and safe nature and its sale or display is in accordance with the laws of California
- Condition: Upon move out the vendor area shall be returned to the condition in which it was received. Vendor is responsible for all waste.
- 6. Health Department Requirements: Food Vendor shall comply with Alameda County Health Department (ACHD) rules and regulations and complete and return a temporary food facility application. All health departments fees must be paid directly to ACHD at least 10 days prior to event to avoid a double payment penalty. Vendors are cautioned that the ACHD guidelines will be strictly enforced. Both civil and criminal penalties apply. If you have any questions about what is required, contact the ACHD at:

Those parties unable to provide required minimum insurance coverage will not be considered. Please refer to the insurance liability coverage requirements page. Make sure that the exhibitor name used on this contract is the same name that is on the certificate of insurance.

- 8. Compliance with Law: Must adhere to all State and County laws. Responsible for obtaining a valid California resale number. For additional information, you may contact the Board of Equalization at 250 South 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, San Jose, CA 95113, (408) 277-1555 Phone/(408) 277-1513 Fax or check their website <a href="https://www.boe.ca.gov">www.boe.ca.gov</a>
- 9. Risk of Loss
  - Damages: Exhibitor assumes all risk of loss or damage to exhibitor's merchandise, equipment, fixtures and property from any cause whatsoever.
  - No Guarantee of Profit: ILLWS makes no guarantees that vendor will make a profit or any monies whatsoever as a result of its activities. Vendors are urged to consider a variety of factors, including weather, traffic and whether the type of product being offered will be attractive and desirable to the fans.
- 10. Dispute Resolution / Legal Fees: Any dispute between the parties shall be resolved by binding neutral arbitration before a neutral arbitrator mutually selected by the parties. If unable to agree on an arbitrator, the presiding Judge of Alameda County shall appoint one. The decision of the arbitrator shall be final. The prevailing party shall be entitled to recover attorney fees. All arbitration shall be held in Alameda County, California where this contract was performed and executed and shall be the exclusive venue for resolution of all disputes.

In the event that a vendor does not conform to the terms of this agreement, LLIWS Directors and Staff have the right to remove the vendor from the facility. All costs associated with removal will be born by the vendor. No refunds will be issued if the vendor is asked to leave. The undersigned warrants that vendor has read, understands, received a copy of this agreement, will abide by the terms and conditions in this. Your signature constitutes your acceptance of the above terms. Your credit card will be charged when this authorization is received.

Policy shall also be endorsed to provide that such insurance is primary insurance and that no separate insurance policy or self-insurance of the additional named insured shall be called on to contribute to any loss incurred in connection with the vendors performance.

The above described coverage shall be maintained through the term of the service agreement and the vendor shall file with LLIWS a Certificate of Insurance (COI) evidencing that any insurance coverage required herein has been obtained and are currently in effect.
